*Please organize your proposal in the following manner:*

**Purpose, aims, research questions, or hypotheses:**

Describe your reasons for doing this research/project and why it is important

**Significance of the problem:**

Describe the problem you are addressing and how your research or project will contribute to the field.

**Project design:**

Explain the design of the study/project that you are proposing.

**Sample:**

Define the sample population you will be using and state your inclusion and exclusion criteria. Describe how you plan to recruit and enroll participants.

Instruments to be used (if appropriate):

**Data Collection and Analysis:**

Describe how you will collect, report, and evaluate your data.

**Project team and expertise:**

Describe the expertise your team has and how they will assist you on this project/research.

**Time-line:**

Outline the anticipated time it will take to accomplish the goals of this study/project.

**Budget:**

Include all pertinent costs that will be associated to this project/research. This could include supplies, education, and participant reimbursement.

**Criteria for Review**

**Is the project/study:**

Relevant to Legacy Grant goals?

Consistent in timeline to the Legacy guidelines?

Lead by a Principal Investigator or Project Director and RN with professional affiliation to LPCH or SUSN?

Focused on nursing practice with clinical application in a variety of settings: In-patient, out-patient, and/or community?

Improving the outcome, quality, and cost effectiveness of patient care?

Designed with measurable outcomes in order to address quality of care and cost effectiveness?

Designed with a plan for dissemination?

Demonstrating scientific merit, rigor, and appropriate funding?
