

Project Objectives And Accomplishments

Objective ADescription of Objective:

Improve access to primary health care services that target high priority Healthy People 2010 Focus Area (FA) diseases prevalent among the medically underserved, predominately homeless client population served by UCSF School of Nursing, Department of Community Health Systems' faculty practice arrangement at Glide Health Services (GHS) in San Francisco's Tenderloin District. (Objective 1 in grant)

Accomplishments:

Objective BDescription of Objective:

Increase access to primary health care through an interdisciplinary nursing case management system that incorporates active street outreach, peer advocacy and social service case management to identify and address HP 2010 FA's prevalent in GHS's client population. (Objective 1a in grant)

Accomplishments:

Activities: --Created biopsychosocial intake tool and trained staff on use. --Increased clinical hours of NP by .6FTE in January 2006. --Implemented interdisciplinary case management meeting, which focuses on case presentations/care plans. --Began tracking clients through use of nursing case management tracking tool. --Opened diabetes group educational visits to GHS clients and outreach to neighborhood for clients not in care. Outcomes: --1,090 new clients (UDC) in 6 months. --Weekly case conferences for case managers. --First Diabetic Group Visit. 2 new clients made appointments to establish care.

Objective CDescription of Objective:

Improve the quality of primary care and reduce health disparities in the GHS client population by implementing the Bureau of Primary Health Care's (BPHC) Health Disparities Collaborative CareModel and HHP 2010 FA guidelines on immunizations. (Objective 1b in grant)

Accomplishments:

Activities: --Integrated Health Disparities Model for Diabetes and Depression into GHS strategic plan in September 2005. --Diabetes Collaborative Activities continue, with focus on clients not in care through activities (group meeting/education, January 2006) and Glide Health Screening Event in February 2006 outreaching to 250 clients for testing/evaluation. --Depression Collaborative – Screening tool selected, and orientation for providers 2/8/06. --Flu vaccine with 2 large outreach activities to food line completed. --Diabetic team meeting bi-monthly or more. --Diabetic Consortium meeting monthly. --Annual Cluster Meeting February, 2006. --PECS data on schedule and up to date. Outcomes: --Current Diabetes Registry of 80 clients. --HgA1c average under 8 for 3 months.

--325 Flu shots administered (campaign not completed). Increased 67% over 2004-2005. --100% of clients with diagnosis of Diabetes currently enrolled in PECS database.

Objective D

Description of Objective:

Expand and enhance GHS's Quality Improvement (QI) plan to evaluate and improve current and ongoing intervention strategies developed through the Pathways initiative. (Objective 1c in grant)

Accomplishments:

Activities: --GHS strategic planning done December 2005. --Ongoing assessment of new data system done to assure tracking key Pathways data. Outcomes: -Flu vaccine tracked through Centricity Data System.

Objective E

Description of Objective:

Increase access to and enhance primary health care services at GHS with linkages through the San Francisco Community Clinic Consortium (SFCCC), Bureau of Primary Health Care Health Disparities Collaborative, and other providers of health care and services to San Francisco's homeless. (Objective 1d in grant)

Accomplishments:

Activities: GHS is sponsoring a community health screening event with UCSF Medical Center, Mt. Zion Cancer Center, UCSF School of Nursing, Glide Memorial Church, St. Francis Memorial Hospital, Hospital Council of Northern California and Kaiser Permanente. The event will be held at Glide on February 10, 2006. We are targeting marginally housed/uninsured clients. Our hope is to see 200-250 clients during the 8 hour event. Peer Advocates are promoting the event together with UCSF and Glide media contacts. Outcomes: 1,090 new clients (UDC) in 6 months.

Objective F

Description of Objective:

Enhance and expand educational and training experiences for UCSF pre-licensure and graduate nursing students who participate in activities in the GHS faculty practice arrangement. (Objective 2 in grant)

Accomplishments:

Objective G

Description of Objective:

Provide enhanced clinical educational experiences for pre-licensure nursing students through their participation in Pathways. (Objective 2a in grant)

Accomplishments:

Activities: Needs assessment survey completed. Data collection in process. Panel discussion including case study discussion completed. Outcomes: Two MEPN students doing clinical rotations during Fall Quarter. Total number of hours = 320. Thirty-eight students participating in panel and case discussions at UCSF.

Objective HDescription of Objective:

Enhance the preparation of advanced practice nursing (APN) students through their participation in Pathways. (Objective 2b in grant)

Accomplishments:

Activities: Needs assessment survey completed. Data collection in process. Have secured clinical placements for ANP and CNS students. Placements for the ANP integrated complementary healing students will be secured in Spring 2006. Culture, Spirituality and Healing class to be offered in Spring 2006. Outcomes: One community health CNS special project completed in Fall 2005. Total number of hours = 4. Four ANP students completed primary care rotations in Fall 2005. Total number of hours = 200. Five ANP students are completing primary care rotations in Winter 2006. Total number of hours = 240. One ANP-Psych student is completing mental health rotation in Winter 2006. Total number of hours = 40. One Psych CNS is completing program planning experience in Winter 2006. Total number of hours = 40
