ADN-MS Pathway Program

- Pathway: for RNs who do not have a baccalaureate degree
- Complete BA or BS degree @ JFKU
- Meet UCSF admission criteria
- Complete studies when planned
- Eligible for MS study at UCSF



ADN-MS Pathway Program



- Why JFKU?
 - Adult learning principles
 - Similar philosophy of teaching/learning
 - Working Adults: Classes nights, weekends, cohort & few on-line
 - Willing to give credit for life/work experiences; "test out" opportunities for credit


ADN-MS Pathway Program



- Why JFKU(2)?
 - Flexible, willing to work with students individually to meet educational goals
 - Focus on preparing students for graduate level writing, critical thinking
 - Challenge students – personal growth
 - Track record of success
